Robbie McEwen is the Legal Director at the Nebraska Appleseed Center for Law in the Public Interest. Prior to becoming Legal Director in 2017, Robbie served as a Staff Attorney in the Child Welfare Program at Appleseed. In his role as Legal Director, Robbie's primary responsibilities are managing Nebraska Appleseed's litigation docket and acting as general counsel to the organization. In his time at Nebraska Appleseed, Robbie has litigated issues involving Medicaid services and eligibility, the Indian Child Welfare Act, the Nebraska Administrative Procedures Act, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, conditions of confinement within state prisons, and other issues related to Nebraska's child-welfare system at both the trial and appellate levels.

Robbie has also served on the board of directors for Nebraskans For Alternatives to the Death Penalty and currently serves on the board of directors for the the Nebraska Indian Child Welfare Coalition. Robbie is currently co-chair of the Nebraska State Bar Association's Volunteer Legal Services Committee and also co-chair of the Courts Matter Coalition of Nebraska.
